My Goals: To go to Hiram Andrews Center or C.O.D.

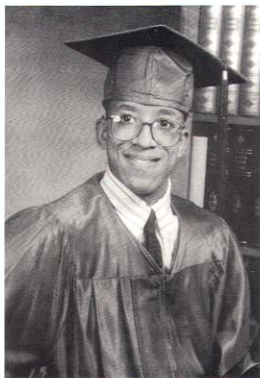

September 26, 1977

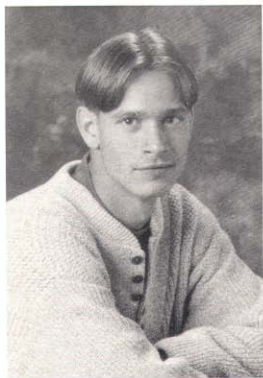
